Meeting Minutes  
December 2, 2021 7:00 pm

- I. Call to Order – Meeting called to order at 7:03pm by Fritz Delinski.
- II. Director's Remarks – Mr. Hoey – Holiday Concert on Tuesday December 7, 2021
  - a. Will be limited to 50% capacity because of rising COVID cases in Michigan
  - b. Each student will receive 2 tickets to concert, any tickets not being use return to Mr. Hoey.
  - c. Extra tickets available to attendees of tonight's meeting, then will be made available to students by seniority
  - d. Uniforms are not ready, students asked to wear nice clothes, no jeans. If a student wants/needs to borrow uniform pieces see Mr. Hoey before concert.
- III. Regular Business
  - a. Reading of the Minutes, minutes accepted
  - b. Disney Trip – Lisa Curtis. Lisa is here tonight to answer any questions about upcoming Disney Trip
    - i. Any chance of cancellation? No expectation of cancellation
    - ii. Do we have agenda? Updated agenda will be sent out after Holidays
    - iii. Do we know hotel yet? Should be on updated agenda

    - i. Balance as of 11/30/2021: \$56,294.26 including student fund money
      1. Deposits –inc. Butter braids, Craft Show and sheet fundraisers, Collage Concert online ticket sales, Kroger and Amazon Smile fundraising. 2021 Craft Show net profit this year \$15, 431.56 inc day of admissions, and crafter space sales. The 2021 show had highest attendance in years.
      2. Withdrawals – inc. SMB expense, payroll for winter guard, student payments to Bennett Travel and Craft Show expense
    - ii. Student fund \$11,598.64
      1. Detailed accounting of your student's fund can be obtained from Vicki, please contact her
      2. if you would like to use your student fund for upcoming 2022 Trip, please fill out voucher available in band room or on school website and submit to Vicki
    - iii. Collage Concert – 25% of online ticket sales will go to Choir booster for their part in ticket sales and organization.
    - iv. Upcoming expense
      1. Large trailer used for carrying instruments/uniforms got a flat on the way to the Brandon Show, while it was able to be temporarily repaired, all tires need replacement. Estimates for replacement have

been obtained and approximate cost for this ranges from \$900.00 to \$1000.00

2. Small Trailer is also undergoing repair, brake/electrical, in anticipation for upcoming Disney Trip.
3. Tailoring for new dresses for girl's band uniform. Because this task is overwhelming for any volunteer to handle (approx. 1.5-2 hours needed per dress with 73 dresses that need hemming) estimates were obtained to have farmed out. By unanimous vote of attendees at tonight's meeting, Sues Alterations will be contracted to hem dresses at \$30/dress.

- d. Fundraising – Diane VerdeZoto, absent tonight. Fundraising report will be emailed out

There are 2 types of fundraising done, general and individual. General fundraising: all money raised goes into the general fund to benefit the program as a whole. Individual fundraising: money raised by each student will be available to them to use toward bands trips, any money not used by the end of the student's involvement in the program will be donated to the general fund, no money will ever be refunded to students.

- i. Just a handful of dresses still need to be fit, all dresses (73) need to be hemmed. (As stated above, this will be contracted out)
  - ii. Urgent Need – a volunteer or group of volunteers is needed to take over uniforms for concert season. It has become too much for Jennifer to take on with working full time and own family obligations.

#### IV. New Business

- a. General Volunteerism – This program is all volunteer based, and a ton of involvement is needed from our Band Booster parents to make it a successful program. If your student is part of the Marching Band, Color Guard or any of the 3 Concert Bands you ARE a Band Booster and we need your help. All games, performances, parades, concerts need parent volunteers to help with coordination of students, uniforms, and instruments. If you are available for any show/performance/concert or game date please show up, there will be a place for you to help.
- b. Holiday Concert (12/7) -Volunteers needed to help with concessions (chaired by Beth Massu), Silent Tree Auction, and ticket collection. Please be at school by 6pm to help.
- c. Marching Band Holiday Party – Lynn O'Neil & Vickie Pelkey co-chairs
  - i. The party will be at school on Friday, December 10 from 6-9pm. It is free to Marching Band students, however it is \$5 cash at the door for any family member wishing to attend.

- ii. There will be a pasta and breadstick dinner, music and varsity letters and 4-year plaques will be awarded to students who have earned them.
- iii. A music playlist is being compiled (no DJ), contact Vicki Schembri with any music requests.
- iv. Volunteers needed to help serve, set-up, clean-up
- v. Dessert donations would be appreciated
- d. Chair for 2022 Band Camp is needed. This happens typically the first 2 weeks of August. Marching band camp costs are kept down because of parent volunteerism, and the lunch provided for the students is crucial to keeping the cost for camp low. Please consider this position for 2022.
