Thanks to donations from many current and past band members and boosters of the CVHS Band Program, this scholarship honors one very special band student who best exemplifies those qualities that were demonstrated regularly by Don Houser. Because this award acknowledges a student who shares their time and efforts without seeking recognition, students should not request nominations. Eligibility is based on the following criteria:

1. The individual is a graduating senior at Chippewa Valley High School.
2. The individual is a current member of the CVHS Band / Color guard. \*\*\*
3. The individual demonstrates a true dedication and commitment to the goals of the CVHS Band Program.
4. The individual displays a true caring and consideration for fellow students and adults alike.
5. Most importantly, the individual does so without a need for praise or recognition.

Nominations for the Donald D. Houser Spirit Scholarship can be submitted by a band parent, band booster, teacher or coach in the form of a letter that describes in detail how this person displays the above Houser qualities and why this nominee should receive this Scholarship.
