Meeting Minutes

May 13, 2021 7:30pm

- I. Call to Order – Meeting called to order at 7:29pm by Lisa Curtis.
- II. Director's Remarks – Mr. Hoey
 - a. Concert – The spring concert is 1 week from today; an email will be sent out with more information.
 - i. No uniforms, students will wear nice clothes to perform, no jeans.
 - ii. Students will need to stay afterschool for set-up and rehearsal. Students will have approximately 1 hour to go home, eat and change prior to concert. However, if students are unsure if they can get a ride back, they should stay until concert. Students can also just choose to stay until concert. Those who are staying should either wear “nice clothes” to school or bring a change of clothes for concert.
 - iii. Dinner will be provided in the cafeteria for those who are staying from rehearsal until performance.
 - iv. Each band will sit in the bleachers as the other bands perform. Audience will sit in bleachers and practice social distancing protocols.
 - v. Students need to plan to stay after concert to help clean up and put equipment away, parents are welcomed to help.
 - vi. There will be no rain date for concert because of scheduling conflict, if it rains the concert will be cancelled.
 - b. Spring Practices – May 25th and June 1st will be spring practice, with middle school students joining. June 1st will also be parent information night. If any current student parent would like to join parent info night to help field questions, and inspire volunteerism, please come.
 - c. Band camp – band camp is planned for the first 2 weeks in August, 8/2/2021 through 8/12/2021. It will be full day camp 8am -4pm with lunch provided for students. 2021 Marching band show will be “Music of Danny Elfman”.

- d. Florida Trip 2022 – response to the Florida 2022 trip has been good and it is expected that we will meet the minimum number of student needed. Deposits are not being collected at this time but it has been arranged for deposit payment of \$100 to be made directly to Bennet Travel, when the time comes.
