February 7, 2019 7:30 PM

Call to Order

- Meeting called to order at 7:31 PM by Mike Passmore.

Director's Remarks

- The District Solo and Ensemble Festival was held on 2/2, and the kids did well. There were 32 events with 27 first ratings and 4 second ratings. The kids with a 1st rating will go on to the State competition March 16th.
- The Winter Band Concert is scheduled for 2/14; the Iroquois Middle School band will be performing at the concert as well. Concert Band will go on first; the concert starts at 7 PM.
- The MSBOA District Band Festival will be held on Friday March 8th at Dakota High School; come and support the band, it is appreciated.
- Mr. Hoey will not be at Parent Teacher Conferences next month; if parents have any questions they may e mail him at any time.
- Reminder – Florida trip information for spring 2020 is out. The initial deposit is \$100; if students do intend to go they should submit their deposit so we can confirm that we have enough students to go (we are just at the edge of the numbers we need to go forth with the trip).

Reading of the Minutes

- Minutes were read by those present; minutes were accepted by Mike Cole and Sue Meyers.

Treasurer's Report

- Bob Czech, treasurer, reports that the account balance of the General Account as of 1/31/19 is \$24,327.58. All bills to date have been paid; Winter Guard instructor fees have been paid (Winter Guard brings in money to the boosters through their shows).
- The Booster Account at PNC Bank has been changed to a Business Checking Account, it is better with less service fees. All signers have now been registered at the bank.
- 1099 tax documents have been mailed, for all people the boosters pay (IE: marching band staff, those who make over \$600).
- Bob Czechs' treasurers' report was accepted by Carla Knotts and Sue Meyers.

❖ **Uniforms**

- The next concert is scheduled for 2/14, with some help needed pass out uniforms; an e mail will be sent.
- Jennifer notes that uniforms have been adjusted for students who have changed band designations or dropped band.
- We still need new Uniform Parents to take over for Katarina and Jennifer.

New Business

- ❖ **MCGC Invitational:** will be held this Saturday 2/9/19; with only Color Guards participating this year. Many volunteers are still needed. Hospitality and Food service is being taken care of, but we still need someone for Admissions (4:15-7:30), spectator door checkers, unit check in (provides packets and assigns guides), unit performer entrance and exit (hold doors), warm up timers (keeps an eye on practice groups). **The Show starts at 3PM with Awards at 7:35PM. The door opens and helpers are needed at approximately 1 PM.
- ❖ **District Band Festival:** it will be held at Dakota H.S. on 3/8; we need parent help to load and to transport the band equipment to Dakota – we will leave Chippewa early afternoon. It is a half day for students; Mr. Hoey will send out call times for students, and Jennifer S. will send out information regarding getting the students ready and any uniform help that is needed.
- ❖ **Drumline Show:** We will now be hosting a Sunday Drumline show on 3/17 for 25 groups as a favor to the shows organizers. Admission will be \$8 for adults and \$5 for students. We will need many volunteers for this event.
- ❖ **State Solo & Ensemble:** is scheduled for 3/16/19. We will have a small concessions and will need to provide hospitality for the judges. Volunteers will be needed for this event as well.
- ❖ **Florida Trip:** there are currently 59 students with deposits submitted for the trip.
